- Circular Economy-presented by TUIASI

During the meeting, the framework and the content of the learning materials were carefully analysed and discussed. The final stage of all these materials will be posted on the Digital Platform of the Project. All the participants agreed on the idea that learning materials must be understandable, easy to access, download and study for any learner who has to self-training and gain new competencies, skills and knowledge. Despite the multidisciplinary nature of the Training Units, it will still allow each user to select the specific area or field wishes to focus on most.

CITEVE partner presented the progress on the development of Training Web Platform (IO5).

The training toolkit will be available in a Digital Platform, and the users could follow the modules corresponding the learning paths and build their self-customised learning paths in order to fill in their skill and knowledge gaps. The courses will be translated in all partner languages. Each partner will be responsible for the translation of the training toolkit in each national language.

The users will have the possibility to download the manual of the ECO-TEX Web Platform to be able to use it as best as it is possible.

The next phase of the project is to test the digital platform in order to evaluate it is friendliness, the satisfaction level regarding the content of the curricula, regarding skills and knowledge gained (expectations vs reality) and if

there is something necessary to improve or change.
