

# Welcome to the 5nd Newsletter Technical Meeting

ECOTEX educational platform, which includes educational material entitled "Sustainability Expert in the field of clothing - textiles" is the major concrete result of the project. The educational material is divided into 4 sections:

Sustainability Management Environmental Performance Corporate social responsibility Circular Economy

The Lead Partner of the project presented the implementation process, quality plan and financial issues.

The material is hosted on the Udemy training platform where those interested can subscribe to access both the training material and the training videos with subtitles, as well as examples of good practices.

The interest that has been expressed both by workers in the clothing - textile industry and by students exceeds all expectations.

From the beginning of March 2020 to July 28th, more than 3,208 people from 121 countries have registered and attended the courses, evaluating the platform with a score of 4.3 with an excellent score of 5. Also on social media (twitter and facebook) the project has more than 830 followers so far.
